Training and CPD by you and your staff

The details below will be from 1 July 2023 – 01 May 2024 as we have already provided details of CPD and training up until 30 June 2023 as per your previous FOI request. foi-005-response-01-august-2023.pdf (biometricscommissioner.scot)

The overall spend for Training and CPD is £1953.62.

Corporate Services Manager attended a Senior Leadership Development Programme at the College of Policing in Coventry from 16–20 October 2023 – the cost of this training was already detailed in the previous FOI as above.

Business Support Officer completed a Data Science SCQF Level 6 at Edinburgh College between September 2023 and February 2024 - free

Corporate Services Manager attended a Management and Leadership MSc at Plymouth University from 22 – 26 January 2024. This course also includes a distance learning element which will run until December 2024 - £950

All team members attended a session with HR Staple at the Perth Mercure Hotel on 7 May 2024 - £1003.62

The Commissioner has not undertaken any training or CPD beyond ICT refresher training which is provided for free by our ICT provider.
